# CDAS Reinstatement Process

Depending on the individual applicant, the reinstatement process can take from 2 days to 9+ months. This is all dependent on the applicant to provide all required documentation (in the proper format\*) in order to successfully reinstate their license with CDAS.

Here is how CDAS staff currently processes reinstatement applications:

1. CDAS registrants submit a reinstatement application which is received via email by CDAS staff.
2. CDAS staff reviews the eligibility of license reinstatement of registrant (ie; if registrant is required to complete the NDAEB CPE)
3. CDAS staff reviews all required documentation and currency requirements (36 PD and 300 Practice Hours) submitted by CDAS registrant and contacts them via email regarding missing or inaccurate documentation. CDAS staff reviews all attestation questions answered by CDAS registrant.
4. Once an application is deemed approved and complete, CDAS staff reviews that proper payment has been received for said reinstatement application.
5. CDAS staff will apply the payment to the registrants' account.
6. CDAS staff notifies the registrant regarding their successful reinstatement.
